Project Description – Scope of Work

The project consists of installation of new 8" water mains to replace existing asbestos cement water mains in the Mariner's Village area and other work related items and abandon the existing water main

Construction will consist of the following:

- ❖ Installation of approximately 5400 LF of 8" PVC water lines and directional boring
- ❖ Installation of approximately 61 water service taps, 40 new meter whips/service connections (bored) and 21 new meter whips/service connections (open cut)
- ❖ Removal and replacement of 25 fire hydrants and 8" gate valves
- ❖ Replacement of sidewalk, driveways and roadway as needed
- ❖ Site restoration work as needed
