The City of Mandeville is requesting proposals from interested firms qualified to furnish all labor, equipment, materials, supervision, and performing all work necessary to provide **EMERGENCY DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL** for the City of Mandeville, Louisiana. All proposals shall be submitted in hard copy by **11:00 A.M.**, local time, **Monday, May 14, 2018**, in the office of the Purchasing Agent, Mandeville City Hall, 3101 East Causeway Approach, Mandeville, LA, 70448. A list of firms who submitted proposals will be made available after 11:00 A.M. Proposals submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

The work consists of providing all labor, equipment and services for removal of all eligible “disaster-generated” debris and all other incidental work as detailed in the specifications. The service contract will be awarded as a standby contract and can be activated upon declaration of a disaster event by City, Parish, State or Federal officials.
