ORDINANCE NO. 24-32

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE TO
AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 24-22, THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE CITY
OF MANDEVILLE AND FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

WHEREAS, Article B, Financial Procedures of the Home Rule Charter provides that amendments to the adopted budget be made by ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Operating Budget adopted for fiscal year 2024-2025, Ordinance Number 24-22, is required due to emergency expenditures associated with the federal, stated, and local state of emergency declarations associated with the impending arrival of Tropical Storm/Hurricane Francine that will exceed the current authorized appropriated funds budgeted for 2024-2025 City of Mandeville Operating Budget;

WHEREAS, Sections 2-06, 2-13A and 5-02 of the Mandeville City Charter and La. R.S. 42:17-42:17.1 allow the City Council to call an emergency meeting to hold a special meeting for the adoption of an emergency ordinance arising out of public emergency affecting life, health, property or public safety, as a result of an extraordinary emergency such as a natural disaster as Tropical Storm/Hurricane Francine;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mandeville that the Operating Budget ordinance for fiscal year 2024-2025, Ordinance Number 24-22, is hereby amended to include the budget amendment as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, incorporated as a part hereof, and be adopted for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Operating Budget.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that in all other respects the 2024-2025 Operating Budget adopted shall remain in full force and effect.
